



SCRAPBOOK CONTEST

REGULATIONS ARE AS FOLLOWS:

1. Each Circle can submit one scrapbook.
2. Scrapbook may include photographs, papers, and anything flat. Do not include items in the book that will force the book not to close. Pictures and other mementos must be identified. Newspaper and/or Newsletter clippings must show the name and date from which they came.
3. All items must be secured well in the scrapbook. Items that fall out will not be judged. Lost pages will not be the responsibility of the Texas State Circle.
4. Circle must have a major activity in each of the four activity areas.
5. Scrapbook must be a regulation binder or photo album and no larger than 16" x 16".
6. Scrap book will be judged on the following criteria:
 - a. Presentation of cover 30 Points Possible
 - b. Content 30 Points Possible
 - c. Neatness 30 Points Possible
 - d. Originality of theme 10 Points Possible
7. Definition of criteria is as follows:
 - a. Presentation of cover: Decoration and appearance of outside cover.
 - b. Content: Can include a wide range of activities
 - c. Neatness: Organization and neatness of pages.
 - d. Originality of theme: Originality of the cover theme
8. Cover must include: Circle name, Circle number, Circle city, and theme title and Fraternal year.
7. Circles must change the theme from year to year.
8. The Squire, NOT THE COUNSELORS OR ANYONE ELSE must do scrapbook.
9. **Scrapbook must be presented to the State Scrapbook Chairman, upon registration at the Annual State Squires Convention. (Friday Night) June 26th, 2009 to be considered.**
